

# End User License Agreement (EULA)

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If the Software has the function "Send information to Licensor", the User can activate and deactivate this function while using the Software, whereas this function is activated by default. Activating this function causes the Software to automatically send software and hardware information to the Licensor from time to time via the existing network connection. This information includes, but is not limited to, the version and area and language settings of the Software, system information about the hardware and data about the use, configuration and problems encountered with the Software. The contents and files created and processed by the User are not sent to the Licensor with this function. The Licensor processes and uses the information sent for statistical purposes and to improve its products and services and will only pass it on to third parties or use it for other purposes with the User's consent. The Licensor does not link the information sent to personal data and does not use it to identify the User or create user profiles.

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- 13.2 If this License Agreement is written in several languages, only the English version is binding and the other versions are for informational purposes only.
- 13.3 This License Agreement and any accompanying order confirmation form issued by Licensor constitute the entire agreement between the parties relating to this subject matter and supersedes all prior or simultaneous understandings, representations, discussions, negotiations, and agreements, whether written or oral. Any different or additional terms in any requests for proposal/quote and purchase orders issued by User or any other similar documents provided by User to Licensor are void, rejected by Licensor and not binding on Licensor.
- 13.4 If any provision of this License Agreement is held to be invalid, unenforceable, or incomplete, the remainder of this License Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. The invalid or unenforceable provision or the filling of the gap shall be replaced by the statutory provisions.
- 13.5 Weather the User is a natural person and lives in the United States, or if the User is a legal entity and its principal place of business is located in the United States or the User is a natural person and lives outside the United States, or if the User is a legal entity and its principal place of business is located outside the United States, the law of the Federal Republic of Germany shall apply to all matters arising out of or relating to this License Agreement. If the law of the Federal Republic of Germany applies and if the User is a company, a legal entity under public law or a holder of special assets under public law, Frankfurt am Main, Germany, shall be the exclusive place of jurisdiction.
